Introducing the School Nursing Service and Parent Portal

Now your child has started school we would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to the Milton Keynes School Nursing Service. We routinely offer a school entrant health screen for all children in Reception Year. This includes the opportunity to identify any health needs that we may be able to support you with. All Reception aged children in State Schools are offered the opportunity to have their vision and hearing screened. Mild problems with vision and hearing are common and can interfere with your child's educational progress which is why these important checks are carried out. **This is the only routine opportunity for these types of check.**

Results will be available when the screening has been completed and any concerns with your child's vision or hearing will be shared with school staff. Following vision and hearing screening your child may require a referral for further assessment at Milton Keynes University Hospital or to a Community Optician.

The School Nursing Service are now using the **School Health Parent Portal**, an electronic method to communicate health information and results letters. In order to view your child's results, you will firstly need to register for a parent portal account.

In the portal you will find a Reception Year Health Questionnaire and information about the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP), as well as in the accompanying letter from Milton Keynes Council. If you do not want your child to be screened there will be an opportunity for you to opt out once registered on the portal, otherwise we will assume you are happy for your child to be screened.

Please take a few minutes to read through the information provided. This will give you a clearer understanding of what it is we aim to deliver.

What do I need to do?

1. Click the link below, this will take you to the registration landing page

2. Register for a school health parent portal account, using just an email

3. Check your email inbox to create a password. It's important that you keep hold of your Username and password for future logins

4. Log into the portal to register your child's details, complete the questionnaire and sign up for receiving feedback.

Who are we and what do we do?

Your School Nursing Service is a team of qualified School Nurses, Registered Nurses, and Health Care Assistants. We are able to support children and young people with the following:

- Healthy lifestyle; including weight and healthy eating
- Body changes, puberty and hygiene
- Support and advice regarding health conditions such as asthma and anaphylaxis
- Anxiety at home or at school / low level emotional well being
- Bullying
- Behaviour concerns
- Poor sleeping patterns
- Concerns regarding vision and hearing
- Bedwetting / Continence issues
- Information regarding smoking, alcohol and drugs
- Relationships and sexual health
- Information about immunisations
- Information about other services and where necessary, referring / signposting to other health professionals or services.

Other services and support from the School Nursing Service includes:

- Hearing and vision screening for Reception Year children
- Height and weight measurements in Reception and Year 6, as part of the National Child Measurement Programme
- Referrals to other health professionals and services
- Support for education staff when a child has a health condition

The School Nursing Service needs to collect certain information about children in the schools in order to provide a service which meets the needs of your child.

Any information you give us is treated confidentially and is held securely. The information is used to plan and provide care and support for your child and will not be shared with the school or other children. If you do not wish to share any information with us, please let us know by opting out of the NCMP, this opt out ensures that we do not see your child for screening and any information will not be shared or used with other services.
